## RESIDENT MATCHING PROGRAM

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANT REGISTRATION

Positions beginning in 2011 in pharmacy residency programs are offered to applicants through the ASHP Resident Matching Program (the "Match"). The Match is sponsored and supervised by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP). The Match is administered on behalf of the ASHP by National Matching Services Inc.

The Match includes both postgraduate year one (PGY1) and postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residencies.

To obtain a position at a residency program that is participating in the Match, applicants must register for and participate in the Match.
